ĆELÁNEN TŦE ŦEŦÁĆES translates in the SENCOTEN language spoken by WSÁNEĆ' Nations as "Birthright/heritage of/to/for our relatives of the deep" . Relatives of the deep refers to the many Islands in the Salish Sea in traditional WSÁNEĆ and Coast Salish territory.

The videos were produced by the FEFÁĆES Revitalization Project co-led by the Southern Gulf Island Community Resource Centre (CRC) and the WSANEC School Board (WSB) with core funding from the Real Estate Foundation of BC. Other funding and inkind support was provided by a number of community partners including the WSB, WSÁNEĆ Leadership Council, Raincoast Conservation Foundation, the Living Lab Network and UVic, the South Pender Historical Society and the Capital Regional District.

The land sovereignty video in particular draws upon traditional knowledge and SENĆOŦEN language to help settlers understand that WSÁNEĆ people belong to the land and have for time immemorial. The video clearly explains why colonial notions of land ownership do not apply to WSÁNEĆ's relationship with TELETÁĆES.
